The hard worker and superb checker spent another season with the Jets after they joined the NHL and retired after the 1979-1980 to begin a long and successful scouting career. He went on to become the Director of Scouting with the Jets and later, the Chicago Blackhawks. As a player, Lesuk broke into the NHL with the Boston Bruins and he also spent time with the Philadelphia Flyers, Los Angeles Kings, and Washington Capitals before signing with the Jets.
